A PROCLAMATION

BUILDING SAFETY MONTH

WHEREAS:	The safety and economic worth of Georgia's buildings, homes, and infrastructure contribute to the growth and prosperity of our state and its communities; and
WHEREAS:	The Peach State's code officials, such as building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, laborers, and others in the construction industry offer a sense of security to our citizens, ensuring that buildings throughout the state are structurally sound; and
WHEREAS:	The dedication of Georgia's code officials in addressing the issues of safety, energy efficiency, and sustainability both in everyday life and in times of natural disaster give us confidence that our structures are durable and dependable; and
WHEREAS:	Construction codes enhance the safety and security of our buildings in the event of emergency scenarios such as snowstorms, hurricanes, tornadoes, earthquakes, and forest fires; and
WHEREAS:	Building Safety Month gives us an opportunity to recognize the contributions made by Georgia's code enforcement officials to provide our citizens with safe, sustainable, and livable buildings; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2019 as BUILDING SAFETY MONTH in Georgia.
