## A PROCLAMATION

## CAR WASH DAY

| WHEREAS:   | Vehicles are significant investments, requiring regular attention to care and<br>service to ensure optimal durability; and   |

| WHEREAS:   | To ensure adequate vehicle care, it is typical for vehicles to be washed once every<br>3 weeks to remove dirt, dust, and grime. This allows vehicle owners to avoid<br>vehicle damage from salt and other substances in addition to preventing the<br>formation of rust; and     |
| WHEREAS:   | Motorists who are commuters or frequent travelers may require additional<br>vehicle care due to more recurrent exposure to both road debris and natural<br>elements; and   |
| WHEREAS:   | The owners and operators of car wash and car care facilities throughout the<br>State of Georgia have demonstrated standards of professionalism by retaining<br>proper credentials, providing quality services, and appropriately addressing the<br>needs of their customers; and |
| WHEREAS:   | Car Wash Day lends Georgia the opportunity to raise awareness of the importance of regular car washes among vehicle owners; and  |
| WHEREAS:   | National Car Wash Day reminds Georgians that regular, proper vehicle care is crucial to the longevity of vehicles; now   |
| THEREFORE: | I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July<br>14, 2019, as CAR WASH DAY in Georgia.   |
