COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK

WHEREAS:	Community corrections is an essential part of the judicial system in the State of Georgia; and
WHEREAS:	Community corrections professionals uphold the law with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be safe-guarded from criminal activity; and
WHEREAS:	Community corrections professionals are responsible for supervising adult and juvenile offenders in communities throughout Georgia; and
WHEREAS:	These trained professionals work in partnership with community agencies and groups in their promotion of prevention, intervention, and advocacy; and
WHEREAS:	Community corrections professionals provide services, support, and protection for victims; and
WHEREAS:	By advocating for community and restorative justice, community corrections professionals are a true force for positive change in Georgia communities; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 21-27, 2019 as COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK in Georgia.
