## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **DREAMHACK DAY**

WHEREAS:	DreamHack is the world's premier gaming lifestyle festival; and
WHEREAS:	The 2019 DreamHack Atlanta festival, the largest in Atlanta to date, will be a twenty-hours-a- day, three-day weekend that includes millions of pro e-sports tournaments, plus collegiate and high school matches, the world-famous LAN party, cosplay, championship, panels, art, expositions, film screenings, live music, and more; and
WHEREAS:	DreamHack is all about entertainment for the digital generation. Over the past twenty-five years, DreamHack has grown into a global phenomenon as the digital festival for today's youth around the world; and
WHEREAS:	DreamHack will celebrate its 25th anniversary on December 9, 2019, honoring the date of the very first DreamHack festival on December 9, 1994. The festival started as a gathering of friends and their computers in a school cafeteria – with no online access – and has grown into a beacon of internet culture and gathering place for gamers worldwide; and
WHEREAS:	The festival's 2019 season has included twelve global host cities, including debuts in Dallas, Texas, U.S.; Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; and Rotterdam, Netherlands. Additional locations have included Leipzig, Germany; Tours, France; Valencia and Sevilla, Spain; Montreal, Canada; New Delhi, India; Jönköping, Sweden; and Atlanta, Georgia, U.S.
WHEREAS:	DreamHack helped pioneer esports and continues to be one of the largest global producers of e-sports content. Millions of viewers tune in from all over the world to watch DreamHack broadcasts every year, and the event welcomed more than 310,000 visitors in 2018; and
WHEREAS:	More than 150 million Americans play video games, and sixty-four percent of American households are home to at least one person who plays video games regularly, or at least three hours per week. In 2019, the global e-sports economy is expected to grow to more than \$1 billion. The global e-sports audience is expected to grow to \$453 million worldwide in 2019; and
WHEREAS:	DreamHack made its Atlanta debut in 2017, bringing nearly 25,000 visitors from a total of forty- eight states and twenty-five countries. Currently, it is one of only three stops in the U.S.; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 15, 2019 as DREAMHACK DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Nineteen.
