WHEREAS: Archives across the state are instrumental in collecting, preserving, and

organizing our state and nation's historical records, and safeguard the

accessibility of these records for the present and future generations; and

WHEREAS: Archives play a vital role in protecting information regarding our intellectual,

cultural, social, and governmental heritage; and

WHEREAS: Records located in the archives hold legal, administrative, fiscal, and historical

value, and contain documentation of the everyday lives, activities, and

circumstances of citizens; and

WHEREAS: Georgia is home to the Georgia Archives, as well as numerous municipal,

county, university, corporate, and private archives that collect and preserve our

state's historical records; and

WHEREAS: Georgia Archives Month will celebrate the 50th Anniversary of The Society of

Georgia Archivists with the theme "Looking Forward, Looking Back: 50 Years

of Preserving Georgia's History"; and

WHEREAS: Georgia Archives Month provides our citizens with an opportunity to increase

public awareness of the value of Georgia's archives by publicizing the many ways historical records enrich our lives, and by recognizing the archivists who

maintain such records; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim
