GEORGIA PHARMACY TECHNICIAN APPRECIATION DAY

WHEREAS:	Pharmacy is one of the oldest of the health professions concerned with the health and well-being of all people; and
WHEREAS:	In 2017, there were an estimated 12,330 practicing pharmacy technicians in the State of Georgia, of which more than 8,419 have obtained national certification; and
WHEREAS:	The Pharmacy Technician Certification Board recognizes the third Tuesday of October of each year as National Pharmacy Technician Day; and
WHEREAS:	Pharmacy technicians have become a major link in today's healthcare chain; and
WHEREAS:	On Georgia Pharmacy Technician Appreciation Day, Georgians are encouraged to acknowledge the valuable services of pharmacy technicians in providing safe, affordable, and beneficial pharmaceutical care services and products; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 15, 2019 as GEORGIA PHARMACY TECHNICIAN APPRECIATION DAY in Georgia.
