WHEREAS:	The GOAL program exemplifies the strong partnerships between Georgia's communities, businesses and industries, and the Technical College System of Georgia, as demonstrated by these organizations' support of this distinguished statewide program recognizing the state's finest technical education students; and
WHEREAS:	Many representatives and sponsors from businesses and industries throughout our state have been generous in donating their time, energy, and products to the GOAL program; and
WHEREAS:	This statewide program strives to stimulate community interest in and knowledge of technical education by recognizing outstanding talent while strengthening the relationship among Georgia's technical colleges and business and industry; and
WHEREAS:	The GOAL program spotlights the importance of technical education in our rapidly-changing technological society by generating greater public awareness of and appreciation for the contributions of a dynamic workforce in Georgia; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P.
