A PROCLAMATION

HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH

WHEREAS:	Historic preservation is an effective tool for economic development, heritage tourism, planning, growth management, neighborhood revitalization, fostering local pride, and maintaining community character while enhancing livability; and
WHEREAS:	Historic preservation is relevant to urban and rural communities throughout the nation, and to Americans of all ages, all walks of life, and all ethnic backgrounds; and
WHEREAS:	It is important to celebrate the role of history in our lives and the contributions made by dedicated individuals in helping to preserve the tangible aspects of the heritage that have shaped us as a people; and
WHEREAS:	Georgia Historic Preservation Month is cosponsored by the Historic Preservation Division of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, The Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation, and other statewide and local organizations throughout Georgia; and
WHEREAS:	Georgia Historic Preservation Month provides an opportunity for citizens of all ages and from all walks of life to recognize the important role that historic preservation plays in individual lives and in communities; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2019 as HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH in Georgia and call upon our citizens to recognize and participate in this special observance of our heritage.
