SAFE DIGGING MONTH

| WHEREAS: | Each year in Georgia, lives are endangered, money and time are wasted, and property is destroyed because of unsafe digging practices; and |

| WHEREAS: | The State of Georgia began the national Safe Digging campaign to advocate for safe digging practices among utility companies, professional excavators, and homeowners; and |
| WHEREAS: | Georgia's one call center motivates statewide excavators to adhere to the message: "Know What's Below, Contact 811 Before You Dig"; and |
| WHEREAS: | Georgia 811 - the Utilities Protection Center – takes calls from the national, federally-mandated "Call Before You Dig" Number, 811, to prevent damage to underground facilities, reducing the loss of time and money to contractors, utilities, and taxpayers; and |
| WHEREAS: | This "one call" system is free to the contractor and the homeowner and helps diggers adhere to the safety rules and regulations of the construction industry; now |
| THEREFORE: | I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 2019 as SAFE DIGGING MONTH in Georgia. |
