WHEREAS:

The citizens of Georgia understand the essential role that education regarding the topic of water safety plays in preventing drownings and recreational water-related injuries; and

WHEREAS:

The recreational water industry has made several contributions that better the quality of life in our communities by developing safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and giving citizens healthy places to learn, grow, and build self-esteem; and

WHEREAS:

The citizens of Georgia recognize the ongoing efforts and commitments to educate the public on pool and spa safety issues and initiatives by the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation and parks industries; and

WHEREAS:

It is vital to communicate the water safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages, whether owners of private pools, users of public swimming facilities, or visitors to waterparks; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2019 as WATER SAFETY MONTH in Georgia.
