A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to amend, consolidate and supersede the several Acts of the General
- 2 Assembly of the State of Georgia pertaining to the City of Molena in the County of Pike (Ga.
- 3 L. 1982, p. 4935), as amended, so as to provide for four-year terms of office for the mayor
- 4 and councilmembers; to provide initial terms of office for the mayor and councilmembers
- 5 elected in 2019 and 2020; to provide for related matters; to provide for the continuation of
- 6 terms of office in effect at the time of adoption; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 An Act to amend, consolidate and supersede the several Acts of the General Assembly of the
- 11 State of Georgia pertaining to the City of Molena in the County of Pike (Ga. L. 1982, p.
- 12 4935), as amended, is amended by revising Section 2.2 as follows:
- 13 "Section 2.2. Terms of Councilmembers. (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c)
- of this Section, each councilmember shall be elected for a term of four years, said election
- to be held on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November immediately
- preceding the expiration of their term of office, and shall take office on the first Monday
- in January of the year following the election.
- 18 (b) To succeed the Post 1 and 2 councilmember terms expiring on December 31, 2019,
- councilmembers to represent Posts 1 and 2 shall be elected on the Tuesday next following
- 20 the first Monday in November 2019, and these initial terms of office shall expire on
- 21 December 31, 2021.
- (c) To succeed the Post 3, 4, and 5 councilmember terms expiring on December 31, 2020,
- councilmembers to represent Posts 3, 4, and 5 shall be elected on the Tuesday next
- 24 following the first Monday in November 2020, and these initial terms of office shall expire
- on December 31, 2023."

- 27 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 2.3 as follows:
- 28 "Section 2.3. Term of Mayor. (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this Section, any
- 29 person elected mayor shall serve a four-year term of office. The election of mayor shall
- 30 be on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November immediately preceding
- 31 the expiration of his or her term of office, and the newly elected mayor shall take office on
- 32 the first Monday in January of the year next following.
- 33 (b) To succeed the mayoral term expiring on December 31, 2019, the mayor shall be
- 34 elected on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November 2019, and this initial
- 35 term of office shall expire on December 31, 2021."

36 SECTION 3.

- 37 The mayor and councilmembers in office on the effective date of this Act shall complete the
- 38 terms of office for which they were elected.

SECTION 4.

40 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
