# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend an Act providing a homestead exemption from City of Commerce independent
2	school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the
3	assessed value of the homestead for certain residents of that school district who are 62 years
4	of age or over and an additional homestead exemption in the amount of \$20,000.00 of the
5	assessed value of the homestead for certain residents of that school district who are 65 years
6	of age or over and whose net income, excluding certain retirement income, does not exceed
7	\$18,000.00, approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4349), as amended, so as to change the
8	net income limitation for receiving such exemptions from \$18,000.00 to \$25,000.00, not
9	including certain retirement income; to provide for a referendum, effective dates, and
10	automatic repeal; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
11	purposes.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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## **SECTION 1.**

14 An Act providing a homestead exemption from City of Commerce independent school 15 district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes in the amount of \$10,000.00 of the assessed value of the homestead for certain residents of that school district who are 62 years 16 17 of age or over and an additional homestead exemption in the amount of \$20,000.00 of the 18 assessed value of the homestead for certain residents of that school district who are 65 years of age or over and whose net income, excluding certain retirement income, does not exceed 19 \$18,000.00, approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4349), as amended, is amended by 20 21 revising paragraph (3) of subsection (a) of Section 2 as follows:

"(3) The exemptions under this subsection shall only be granted if that person's net
income, together with the income of the spouse who also occupies and resides at such
homestead, does not exceed \$25,000.00 for the immediately preceding taxable year."

#### **SECTION 2.**

26 The election superintendent of the City of Commerce shall call and conduct an election as 27 provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the City of 28 Commerce independent school district for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the date of the 2020 presidential preference primary and shall 29 30 issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The superintendent shall 31 cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of the City of Commerce. The 32 33 ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

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"( ) YES Shall the Act be approved which changes the net income limitation from \$18,000.00 to \$25,000.00, excluding certain retirement income, for the homestead exemptions from City of Commerce independent school district ad valorem taxes for educational purposes for certain senior citizens?"

38 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes 39 40 cast on such question are for approval of the Act, Section 1 shall become of full force and 41 effect on January 1, 2021, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2021; provided that legislation to increase the net income limitation from 42 43 \$18,000.00 to \$25,000.00 for homestead exemptions from ad valorem taxes for educational purposes for senior citizens residing in the Jackson County School District and the City of 44 Jefferson independent school district is also passed in the 2019 session of the Georgia 45 General Assembly and ratified by the electors in those respective districts at the 2020 46 presidential preference primary. If the Act is not so approved, if the election is not conducted 47 as provided in this section, if legislation to increase the net income limitation from 48 49 \$18,000.00 to \$25,000.00 for homestead exemptions from ad valorem taxes for educational purposes for senior citizens residing in the Jackson County School District and the City of 50 Jefferson independent school district, or if such legislation to increase the net income 51 52 limitation is not ratified by the electors of either the Jackson County School District or the City of Jefferson independent school district, Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective 53 and this Act shall be automatically repealed on the first day of January immediately 54 55 following that election date. The expense of such election shall be borne by the City of 56 Commerce. It shall be the election superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the 57 Secretary of State.

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### **SECTION 3.**

- 59 Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon
- 60 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

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62 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
