A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Monroe County; to provide for the
- 2 appointment of a county surveyor by the governing authority of the county; to provide that
- 3 the person currently serving as elected county surveyor shall serve out the remainder of his
- 4 or her term; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Pursuant to the authority granted by Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A., the office of
- 9 elected county surveyor of Monroe County is hereby abolished. The governing authority of
- 10 Monroe County shall appoint a qualified person to hold the office of county surveyor for a
- term of one year from the date of appointment. Successors shall also be appointed for terms
- 12 of one year. Any person appointed county surveyor shall possess the qualifications specified
- 13 by paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 36-7-2 of the O.C.G.A. Any person
- 14 elected and serving as the county surveyor of Monroe County on July 1, 2019, shall continue
- 15 to serve as such until the expiration of the current term to which such person was elected and
- 16 no further elections shall be held for such office.

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become law upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
