A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 6 of Chapter 7 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to retirement, retirement allowances, disability benefits, and death benefits relative
- 3 to the Georgia Firefighters' Pension Fund, so as to provide that a member's benefits payable
- 4 after death shall be paid to his or her estate when such member failed to designate a
- 5 beneficiary or his or her designated beneficiaries are deceased; to provide for related matters;
- 6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 6 of Chapter 7 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 retirement, retirement allowances, disability benefits, and death benefits relative to the
- 11 Georgia Firefighters' Pension Fund, is amended by revising Code Section 47-7-103, relating
- 12 to benefits payable to a named beneficiary upon death of members prior to the
- 13 commencement of benefits or payment of benefits equal to members' dues, as follows:

- 15 (a) In the event of the death of an active member who has not commenced receiving any
- benefits under this chapter, up to five selected beneficiaries of such deceased member shall
- be entitled to be paid the amount of \$5,000.00 split equally among the selected
- beneficiaries, upon any selected beneficiary making proper application to the executive
- director of the fund. Such application shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the death
- 20 certificate of the deceased member and such other information as may be required by the
- board.
- 22 (b) In the event of the death of a retired member of the fund who has not elected survivor
- benefits under Option A or B as provided for in subsection (d) of Code Section 47-7-100
- and who has commenced receiving benefits under this chapter, but who has not received
- total benefits in an amount equal to \$5,000.00, up to five beneficiaries selected by the
- 26 member shall be entitled to receive an equally apportioned amount from the difference

between \$5,000.00 and the amount of benefits received by such deceased member, upon making application as provided for in subsection (a) of this Code section.

- 29 (c) In the event of the death of an active member or a retired member who failed to
- 30 <u>designate a beneficiary, or if all named beneficiaries have predeceased such member, any</u>
- 31 <u>benefits otherwise payable under subsections (a) or (b) of this Code section shall be</u>
- 32 payable to such member's estate."
