A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 35-8-7.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 authority of council to refuse certificate to applicant or to discipline council certified officer
- 3 or exempt officer, grounds, restoration of certificate, emergency suspension of certification,
- 4 and notice of investigation, so as to provide that records of investigation of an officer by the
- 5 Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council shall be retained for 30 years; to
- provide for destruction of such records; to provide for an exception; to provide for related 6
- 7 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 10 Code Section 35-8-7.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to authority of
- 11 council to refuse certificate to applicant or to discipline council certified officer or exempt
- 12 officer, grounds, restoration of certificate, emergency suspension of certification, and notice
- 13 of investigation, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 14 "(g) Notwithstanding Article 5 of Chapter 18 of Title 50, records of an investigation of an
- 15 officer by the council, including, but not limited to, records used to investigate complaints
- against an officer and polygraph case files containing official polygraph reports, shall be 16
- 17 retained for 30 years following the date that such investigation is deemed concluded by the
- council and then such records may be destroyed; provided, however, that the council shall
- 19 have the authority to destroy such records prior to such 30 years where such officer is
- 20 deceased and no action upon the complaint was taken by the council beyond the council's
- 21 initial intake of such complaint."
