

House Bill 610 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To authorize the Magistrate Court of Carroll County to charge a technology fee for each
2 conviction of a traffic or ordinance violation and each civil case; to specify the uses to which
3 said technology fee may be put; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 (a) The clerk of the Magistrate Court of Carroll County shall be entitled to charge and
8 collect a technology fee to be set by the court in the amount of \$3.00 as a surcharge to each
9 conviction for a traffic or ordinance violation and each civil case. Technology fees shall
10 be used exclusively to provide for the technological needs of said court.

11 (b) The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be maintained in a segregated fund by
12 the clerk of the magistrate court and shall be used only for the purposes authorized in this
13 section.

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
