A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to create the Camden County Public Service Authority, approved 2 March 30, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4273), as amended, so as to revise a definition; to provide 3 for the composition of the Authority; to provide for an annual certified audit; to provide for 4 related matters; to provide for a referendum; to provide for contingent effective dates and 5 automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	An Act to create the Camden County Public Service Authority, approved March 30, 1990
9	(Ga. L. 1990, p. 4273), as amended, is amended by revising subparagraph (c)(1)(F) of
10	Section 2 as follows:
11	"(F) 'Project' means:
12	(i) All buildings, facilities, and equipment necessary or convenient for the efficient
13	operation of:
14	(I) Camden County, Georgia, or any department, agency, division, or commission
15	thereof; or
16	(II) Any other political subdivision or municipality of the State of Georgia located
17	within Camden County, Georgia; and
18	(ii) Any undertaking permitted by the 'Revenue Bond Law.'"
19	SECTION 2.
20	Said Act is further amended by revising subsection (f) of Section 2 as follows:
21	''(f)(1) The Authority shall be composed of nine members: the members shall include the
22	elected official or appointee of the City of Kingsland, the City of St. Mary's, and the City
23	of Woodbine and the elected official or appointee for the County of Camden. Each city
24	council shall appoint one resident from their respective city to serve on the Authority and
25	the county board of commissioners shall appoint two residents of the county to serve on

the Authority. With respect to the resident member appointments, each shall be appointed for a term of three years. Immediately after such appointments, the resident members of the Authority shall enter upon their duties. Each of such resident members shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified. The Authority board members serving as of the effective date of this Act shall serve until their term is completed.

32 (2) To be eligible for appointment as a member of the Authority, a person shall be at
33 least 21 years of age and a resident of Camden County for at least two years prior to the
34 date of his or her appointment and shall not be a convicted felon.

35 (3) Any member of the Authority may be selected and appointed to succeed himself
36 or herself. A member may be removed from office for failure to perform the
37 appropriate duties of membership.

(4) The members of the Authority shall elect one of their number as chairperson and
another as vice chairperson. The members of the Authority shall also elect a secretary,
who need not be a member of the Authority, and may also elect a treasurer, who need
not be a member of the Authority. The secretary may also serve as treasurer. If the
secretary and treasurer are not members of the Authority, such officers shall have no
voting rights. Each of such officers shall serve for a period of one year and until their
successors are duly elected and qualified."

SECTION 3.

46 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 6 as follows:

- 47 "SECTION 6.
- 48 Annual Audit.

Each year the Authority shall have made an independent certified audit and examination of the Authority's previous fiscal year financial records and transactions. Said audit shall be made on or before October 1 of each year. The audit shall be conducted in accordance with established national audit and accounting standards. Copies of said audit shall be available for public review and provided to each participating jurisdiction."

SECTION 4.

55 The election superintendent of the County of Camden shall call and conduct an election as 56 provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the County 57 of Camden for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct such election 58 on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 2019, and shall issue the call and 59 conduct such election as provided by general law. The election superintendent shall cause

60 the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately

- 61 preceding the date thereof in the official organ of the County of Camden. The ballot shall
- 62 have written or printed thereon the words:
- 63 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which amends the Act creating the Camden
- 64 () NO County Public Service Authority?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring 65 to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the votes cast on 66 such question are for approval of the Act, then Sections 1 through 4 of this Act shall become 67 effective upon approval of such Act by the voters in 2019. If more than one-half of the votes 68 69 cast on such question are for rejection of the Act or if the election is not held as provided in this section, then this Act shall not become effective and Sections 1 through 4 of this Act 70 71 shall be automatically repealed upon the rejection of such Act by the voters in 2019. The expense of such election shall be borne by the County of Camden. It shall be the election 72 superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of State. 73

SECTION 5.

75 Except as otherwise provided in Section 5 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon

76 its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

SECTION 6.

78 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
