AS PASSED

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To authorize the Probate Court of Troup County to charge a technology fee; to specify the
2 uses to which said technology fee may be put; to provide for related matters; to repeal
3 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 (a) The clerk of the Probate Court of Troup County shall be entitled to charge and collect
7 a technology fee to be set by the court in the amount of \$10.00 as a surcharge to each filing
8 of a civil action or proceeding. Technology fees shall be used exclusively to provide for the
9 technological needs of said court, including the purchase of hardware, software, and
10 technical support services.

11 (b) The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be maintained in a segregated fund by
12 the clerk of the probate court and shall be used only for the purposes authorized in this
13 section.

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
