A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 special license plates promoting and supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit
- 3 corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit
- 4 corporation, so as to establish a specialty license plate to benefit the Atlanta United
- 5 Foundation; to provide for related matters; to provide for compliance with constitutional
- 6 requirements; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
- 11 plates promoting and supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations
- with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation,
- is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:
- 14 "(58) A special license plate supporting the Atlanta United Foundation. The funds raised
- by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed as provided for in paragraph (1)
- of this subsection to the Atlanta United Foundation and used for the foundation's
- philanthropic activities. Such special license plate shall not include a space for the
- county name decal but shall instead bear the phrase 'Unite & Conquer'."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph (VI)(n) of the
- 21 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
- 22 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.
