



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to certain real property by virtue of a March 8, 1938 fee simple deed from R.C. Howell for approximately 750 acres recorded in Early County Clerk of Superior Court in Deed Book 55, Page 555 (the "Property"); and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Natural Resources (the "Department") and was acquired as part of the Kolomoki Mounds State Park; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property improvements include an approximate 2,400 square foot pool concession/bathhouse, as shown in that aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference (the "Structure"); and
- WHEREAS:** Said Structure is identified by the Department to no longer be essential for park operations, unsafe in their current condition, declared to have no value, and the Department recommends the removal of the Structure; and
- WHEREAS:** The Board of Natural Resources on September 23, 2015, resolved to recommend the removal of the Structure and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structure as in the best interest of the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** The Department of Natural Resources has funding available to raze, demolish, and dispose of said Structure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

- ORDERED:** The Department of Natural Resources is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
