EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS IN COBB COUNTY, GEORGIA ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: On Monday, April 10, 2017, Ron Cornelis Herens, 23, of Powder Springs was killed in a horrific automobile accident; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Herens was a firefighter with the Marietta Fire Department, and an EMT with Puckett Ambulance Service. He was active with the Cobb County Fire Explorers and received the Cares Award in March 2015; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Mr. Herens' service to the citizens of Cobb County and the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF RON CORNELIS HERENS, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and flag of the Great State of Georgia be flown at half-staff in Cobb County, Georgia, on Wednesday, April 19, 2017, the day of Mr. Herens' interment, until sunset.
