BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On March 18, 2014, in Toccoa, Georgia, Mr. Montevious

Flentall was violently murdered in his home; and

WHEREAS: The Toccoa Police Department, with the assistance of the

Georgia Bureau of Investigation, conducted an investigation

but have been unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated

provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has

committed a felony.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested

HEREBY

Ordered: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered

for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the murder of

Mr. Montevious Flentall.
