EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The quality of education of Georgia's students is the top priority of this state; and

WHEREAS: This state will strive to provide quality education to every student regardless of that student's school district or school; and

WHEREAS: Every school district and school in this state will be held to the highest standard; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 20-2-73, when a local school system or school has been placed on the level of accreditation immediately preceding loss of accreditation for school board governance related reasons and does not retain full accreditation, the State Board of Education shall recommend to the Governor whether to suspend all eligible members; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to this same code section, if the State Board of Education makes a recommendation to suspend, the Governor may suspend all eligible members and appoint temporary replacement members; and

WHEREAS: Under the provisions outlined above, the State Board of Education has recommended to the Governor the suspension of all eligible members of the Dooly County Board of Education; and

WHEREAS: A committee composed of education professionals and advocates best ensures the highest quality of replacement school board members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That following eligible members of the Dooly County School Board are hereby suspended: Ms. Melvilla West, Mr. Kenneth Kellogg, Mr. Eddie Almond, Ms. Freda Haddock, and Ms. Janie Winters.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That there is created the Dooly County School Board Nominating Committee. The Committee shall make nominations to the Governor in a timely manner to replace the suspended board members of the Dooly County School Board.


IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the Committee shall consist of Ms. Helen Rice, a current member of the State Board of Education; Mr. William "W.T." Henry, Sr., a former member of the State Board of Education from the congressional district in which the school board at issue is located; The Honorable Greg Kirk, the presiding state senator over the area in which the school board at issue is located; The Honorable Patty Bentley, the presiding state representative over the area in which the school board at issue is located; Mr. Hobby Stripling, Sr., mayor of the city of Vienna; Mr. Gregory McClendon, pastor of Christ Chapel Unadilla. Ms. Helen Rice shall serve as chair of the committee.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That members of the Committee shall serve without compensation, but are entitled to receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties for the Committee. Such reimbursement shall be expended from funds appropriated to or otherwise available from the Office of the Governor of the State of Georgia.
