

House Bill 1059 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Murray County; to provide for the
2 appointment of a county surveyor by the governing authority of the county; to provide that
3 the person currently serving as elected county surveyor shall serve out the remainder of his
4 or her term; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Pursuant to the authority granted by Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A., the office of
8 elected county surveyor of Murray County is hereby abolished. The governing authority of
9 Murray County shall appoint a qualified person to hold the office of county surveyor for a
10 term of one year from the date of appointment. Successors shall also be appointed for terms
11 of one year. Any person appointed county surveyor shall possess the qualifications specified
12 by paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 36-7-2 of the O.C.G.A. Any person
13 elected and serving as the county surveyor of Murray County on the effective date of this Act
14 shall continue to serve as such until the expiration of the current term to which such person
15 was elected, and no further elections shall be held for such office.

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
