BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

- 9 An Act creating the Satilla Regional Water and Sewer Authority, previously known as the
- 10 Ware County Water and Sewer Authority, approved October 1, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, Ex. Sess.,
- 11 p. 705), as amended, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (d) of Section 2 as
- 12 follows:

- 13 "(1) Prior to each election for the position of a member of the authority, the authority
- 14 shall establish a period of time for the submission of nominations of candidates. Each
- 15 sitting member of the authority shall be entitled to nominate one candidate. Additionally,
- any account holder shall be entitled to submit one petition for nomination of a candidate, 16
- 17 provided that such petition, to be valid, shall be accompanied by the signatures of at
- least 15 other account holders. Following the close of the nominations period, the
- 19 authority shall designate for inclusion on the election ballot the name of each candidate
- 20 nominated by a sitting authority member, as well as the name of each candidate for which
- 21 a valid petition for nomination was submitted;".

- 23 Section 24.1 of the Act is repealed in its entirety.
