

House Bill 630 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of elections and registration for Polk County, approved
2 March 30, 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 4652), so as to provide for districts; to provide for terms of
3 office; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 An Act creating a board of elections and registration for Polk County, approved March 30,
7 1989 (Ga. L. 1989, p. 4652), is amended by revising Section 2 as follows:

8 style="text-align:center">"SECTION 2.

9 The board shall be reconstituted effective January 1, 2014, as provided for in this section;
10 until such date, those members of the board serving on January 1, 2013, shall continue to
11 serve. The board shall be composed of three members with one member representing each
12 commissioner district of Polk County. The members of the board shall be an elector and
13 resident of the commissioner district they represent. Members of the board shall be
14 appointed thereto by the Board of Commissioners of Polk County which shall also designate
15 one of those members to be the chairperson of the board of elections and registration. The
16 first members of the board from each commissioner district shall be appointed for an initial
17 term beginning January 1, 2014. The member representing Commissioner District 1 shall
18 serve for an initial term ending December 31, 2015; the member representing Commissioner
19 District 2 shall serve for an initial term ending December 31, 2016; and the member
20 representing Commissioner District 3 shall serve for an initial term ending December 31,
21 2014. After the initial terms of office, successors to members whose terms are to expire shall
22 be appointed to take office the first day of January immediately following that expiration of
23 term and shall serve for terms of four years each and until their successors are duly appointed
24 and qualified."

SECTION 2.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
