A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act creating the State Court of Ware County, formerly the City Court of Waycross, approved December 11, 1897 (Ga. L. 1897, p. 510), as amended, particularly by an Act approved July 30, 1903 (Ga. L. 1903, p. 171), so as to provide that the clerk of the superior court of Ware County shall also be the clerk of the state court of Ware County; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 An Act creating the State Court of Ware County, formerly the City Court of Waycross, 10 approved December 11, 1897 (Ga. L. 1897, p. 510), as amended, particularly by an Act 11 approved July 30, 1903 (Ga. L. 1903, p. 171), is amended by revising Section 3 as follows: 12 "Sec. 3. The clerk of the superior court of Ware County shall also be, by virtue of his or her office and authority bestowed by Chapters 6 and 7 of Title 15 of the O.C.G.A., the 13 14 clerk of the state court of Ware County. Said clerk shall, on behalf of the county and as an 15 expense of court, receive compensation for services in such courts as entitled by Chapters 6 and 7 of Title 15 of the O.C.G.A. The clerk of the state court shall have all authority 16 bestowed upon him or her by Chapters 6 and 7 of Title 15 of the O.C.G.A. The clerk shall 17 18 also supply all of the necessary personnel, equipment, supplies, and materials for the proper 19 functioning of the state court, and the sheriff shall provide those services to the state court as are provided to the superior court of Ware County. All of the expenditures authorized 20 21 in this section are declared to be expenses of the court and payable out of the county 22 treasury as such."

SECTION 2.

24 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2020.
