

House Bill 682 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to re-create and establish the Board of Commissioners of Long County,
2 approved March 10, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3755), as amended, so as to provide for staggering
3 of terms of office for commissioner districts; to provide for related matters; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to re-create and establish the Board of Commissioners of Long County, approved
8 March 10, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3755), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (b)
9 of Section 3 as follows:

10 "(b) Members of the board representing Commissioner Districts 1 and 4 elected at the
11 November general election in 2020 shall take office the first day of January immediately
12 following that election and serve for terms of four years and until their respective
13 successors are elected and qualified. Members of the board representing Commissioner
14 Districts 2, 3, and 5 shall be elected at the November general election in 2020, take office
15 the first day of January immediately following that election, and serve for initial terms of
16 two years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified. All future
17 successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to expire shall be elected at
18 the November general election immediately preceding the expiration of such terms, take
19 office the first day of January immediately following that election, and serve for terms of
20 four years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
