- 3 mayor and councilmembers; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act to incorporate the City of Johns Creek in Fulton County, Georgia, approved
- 8 March 29, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 3503), as amended, is amended by adding new subsections
- 9 to Section 2.10 to read as follows:
- 10 "(c) No person elected as mayor in the general municipal election of 2019, or any election
- thereafter, shall serve as mayor for more than three consecutive, four-year terms of office
- and shall not include any partial terms of office. No terms of office served prior to
- January 1, 2020, and no terms of office served as a councilmember shall be considered in
- determining if a person has served more than three consecutive terms of office.
- 15 (d) No person elected as councilmember in the general municipal election of 2019, or any
- election thereafter, shall serve as councilmember for more than three consecutive, four-year
- terms of office and shall not include any partial terms of office. No terms of office served
- prior to January 1, 2020, and no terms of office served as mayor shall be considered in
- determining if a person has served more than three consecutive terms of office."

SECTION 2.
